The Living In The Miracle Group continues to meet two times a week on Sunday and Friday with an average attendance of 18 addicts per meeting. We alternate reading from the Basic ext and It Works: How and Why. On the first Sunday of the month we have a candlelight meeting where we read from a selected pamphlet.

We also hold a games night every third Friday of the months. Everyone is welcome.

The held our monthly business meeting on Sunday, May 3, 2026 with 7 home group members in attendance. Business meetings will now occur the first Sunday of every month.

During this cycle the group brought in \$507 in 7<sup>th</sup> contributions and literature sales. Our total expenses were \$166.30, rent \$170 and \$101.50 was placed in our Prudent Reserve to restore the balance to \$500. We place a literature order for \$115.53. ## **Literature Coordinator Report**

A breakdown of what literature is in stock was provided. Looked at history over last three years. It was noted some books and pamphlets rarely get ordered. Graphs were included in the report that demonstrated the frequency of purchase of all items.

It was noted it takes a couple weeks to receive supplies if they are not in stockpile. It was identified that Version 25 literature order form has a formula error in it.

Purpose of literature breakdown was to reduce the amount of stockpile we maintain. Value today is \$3,298.65. With recommended reduction from Literature Coordinator, the value could be reduced to approximately \$2,300, saving approximately \$1,000 by not replacing the excess stockpile.

An order was placed on May 3, 2026 for \$351.80 CDN.

Consensus to accept recommendations to reduce stockpile to approximately \$2,300.00.

See inventory attached as Appendix A.

Paul C advised he would be happy to develop an on-line store. The store would be designed to enable the individual ordering to see quantities of stock, input their orders directly and send a notification to the Literature Coordinator to fill the order.

Paul C also brought a box of the Introductory Guide to NA to be distributed.

Groups were also asked if they want the Money Matters (IP 24) and Funding NA Services (IP 28) donated since we have several in stock and they rarely get ordered. It was also noted there are several PI and the NA Member (IP 15). It was suggested to have a workshop at next ASC regarding financial matters.

Consensus to hold the workshop next ASC.

ACTION – Paul C. and Julia H agreed to work on the development of a financial matters workshop together to be presented at next Area.

## **Web Coordinator Report**

Paul C unofficially stepped in and offered to assist in the absence of a Web Coordinator. Several information updates have been made. Some new software was uploaded, including a form at the top of the calendar where groups can submit an anniversary or event. It will go to Paul C and he will add it to the calendar. Full disclosure, there was a cost associated with this and Paul C covered the cost as a donation to NA. There is also a contact form on the site that has been redirected to Paul.

Five Inquiries were received via the website and responded to. One was a request to start a new meeting.

Website translation – Paul C has sent emails to the translator but has not received any response. That individual is very busy. Paul is using software that is available and is working on translating website information. Presently you can go to the website and select English or French. Has about 2 pages that are translated so far.

Question from PI Point Person regarding whether the inquiries should be directed to him for response. A report should be provided by folks doing H&I in prisons. To be discussed under Open Forum. Will also be discussed at PR Meeting.

### **Workshop**

### **Treasurer's Report**

No Treasurer Report.

Treasurer's resignation letter was read by the Secretary. This also included the role of Web Servant.

After conducting its business, the Area had a donation of \$398.92 to make to the Regional Service Committee. It was agreed the Chairperson would meet with the past Treasurer to ensure the income and expenses were correctly captured and calculated in the spreadsheet.

ACTION – Andrea P will post the amount of the donation to be made to RSC in the Admin Team chat.

### **Old Business**

1. Positions available at the Regional level: Alternate Delegate, Vice Chair, Web Coordinator, PR Chairperson, and Treasurer.
2. Canadian Convention is looking to fill the position of Hospitality Point Person. If you're interested, please apply at [canadianconvention.com](http://canadianconvention.com).
3. Web Coordinator to update website with new literature order form (Version 26).  
The suggestion of setting up a Literature Store was discussed. It could be set up with login accounts for each group to limit access. Consensus to proceed.  
ACTION - Paul C will create the Literature Store with objective to have it set up for a couple weeks prior to next Area meeting.
4. Literature Coordinator will review stock and determine where adjustments can be made to reduce old stock – Completed and discussed under Literature Coordinator Report.
5. Literature Coordinator will report back to next Area where the committee will determine what to do with extra stock – Completed and discussed under Literature Coordinator Report.

6. Treasurer will send \$1,043.39 to RSC via Electronic Funds Transfer (January 21<sup>st</sup>, 2026 donation of \$101.00 and March 21<sup>st</sup>, 2026 donation of \$942.39) – this requires follow up.  
ACTION – Admin to follow up with past Treasurer to determine whether payment has been made to RSC in the amount of \$1,043.39.
7. Treasurer to verify with bank regarding possibility of e-transfer payments to RSC – this requires follow up.  
ACTION – Admin to follow up with past Treasurer to determine whether e-transfer payments can be made to RSC.
8. GSRs to advise their groups a work group is being established to develop NANB Guidelines on how to deal with Disruptive, Sexual & Predatory behavior and seek volunteers to participate on the work group – this was completed. The work group met, draft guidelines developed and sent to Area Admin and all GSRs. Several GSRs indicated they did not take them to their groups.  
ACTION – GSRs are to take the draft guidelines on Disruptive, Sexual & Predatory Behavior to their groups for input and potential acceptance. To be addressed at next Area meeting.
9. RCM will resend updated RSC guidelines to the two GSRs who stated they did not receive the original email – Completed.
10. GSRs to take updated guidelines back to groups for feedback by next Area cycle – no comments received.

## **Open Forum (Group Concerns)**

1. Funded Travel  
Paul C. raised a concern that the intent of the funded travel (known as the Fellowship Development Fund) has been expanded and respectfully requested this practice be reevaluated. The importance of funding travel for service was raised and agreed this should remain. It was noted the intent of the Fellowship Development Fund should be captured in the NANB Guidelines. Current “guidelines” are that gas reimbursements can be made for travel to meetings in other cities assuming there are a minimum of two members in a vehicle.

ACTION – GSRs go back to groups regarding use of the Fellowship Development Fund to determine whether funding travel to meetings in other cities is the best use of NA funds at the Area level.

## **New Business**

1. Web Servant Position – responsibilities and clean time requirements were read by the Secretary. Paul C. was nominated (Penny A/Kim F). Paul C indicated willingness to serve on a temporary basis and willing to familiarize someone who takes on the position. It was noted the responsibilities are outdated. The potential of outsourcing was discussed.  
ACTION – Paul C will provide Andrea P with a description of the Web Coordinator role.  
ACTION – GSRs to seek interest from their groups for the Web Coordinator position.
2. Treasurer Position – responsibilities and clean time requirements were read by the Secretary. As an interim measure the Admin Team is responsible, the Chairperson and Secretary will look after the actual accounting component.  
ACTION – GSRs to seek interest from their groups for the Treasurer position.
3. Disruptive and Predatory Behavior Guidelines – already addressed.

4. South East (DECH) donations – Kim F presented information regarding a project she is involved in and submitted a request for donation from Area of printed information for 240 packages (20 packages for 12 months). It was agreed that to be in accordance with Tradition Six, Area is unable to contribute.

There was discussion about making donations directly to such units in hospitals. Consensus to discuss in the PR meeting.
